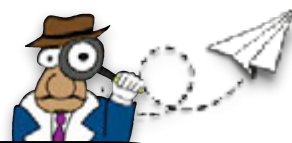
1. Josh wrote down a number sequence. He said "My number sequence has six numbers altogether. Some of the numbers in my sequence are 4, 12 and 16."
