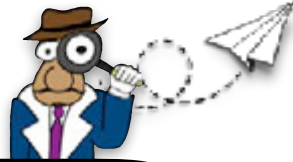
1. Josh wanted to buy a bag of sweets that cost £1. He had 65p. How much money would Josh need to save in order for him to be able to afford the bag of sweets?
