



# Numbers - first steps



## Let's start

Counting to 6

### Tea time game

You need a dice with numbers 1-6 on.

- A cup is number 1.
- A saucer is number 2
- A plate is number 3.
- A knife is number 4
- A fork is number 5.
- A spoon is number 6

Children take turns to throw the dice and collect the items. The winner is the first to collect a full set.

## Next Step

Counting to 10

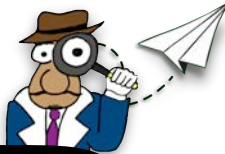
### The Teddy Bear Train

1 teddy bear goes out one day  
Onto a train and far away,  
He finds it such enormous fun,  
That he wants another teddy bear to come.

Child to say rhyme and choose a teddy bear out of a basket of teddy bears to add to a picture of a train and carriages, counting the bears as they go along. Repeat the rhyme:

2 teddy bears go out one day  
Onto a train and far away,  
They find it such enormous fun,  
That they wants another teddy bear to come.

Repeat up to 10 teddy bears



## You can do it!

Counting to 12

### Hickory Dickory Dock

Hickory, dickory, dock,  
The mouse ran up the clock.  
The clock struck one,  
The mouse ran down,  
Hickory, dickory, dock.

Arrange large number cards into a clock face on the floor. Child picks out a number at random from their own pack of 1-12 cards then places a toy mouse on the corresponding number on the floor.
